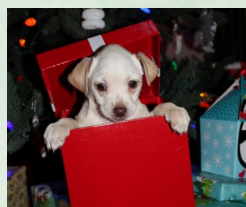

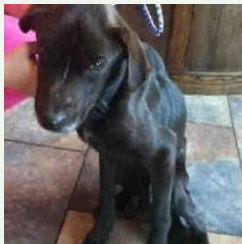

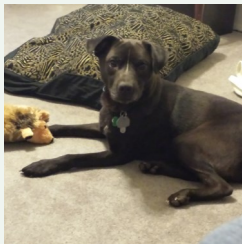


Slater Finds Love with a Perfect Family

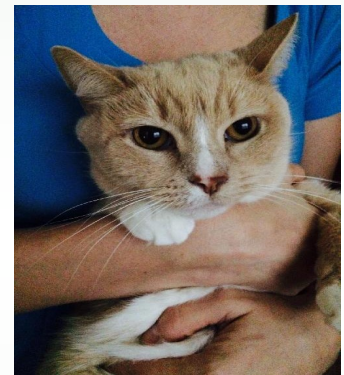

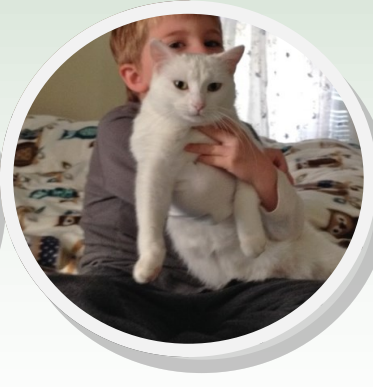
Dasha has the most bright golden eyes and shiny black fur. She was raised in a home with children and would love to be around them again. She would like to be an only pet.

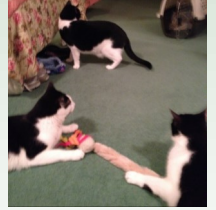

Thanks again Diana for being such a dedicated volunteer & for loving so much & giving the three boys the best home ever.

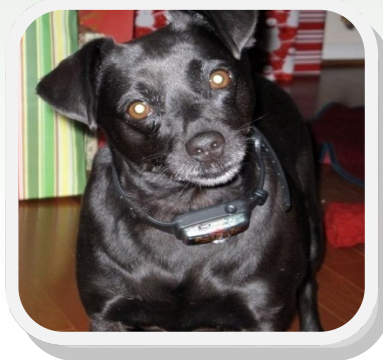

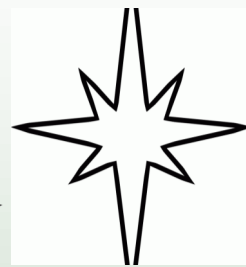
