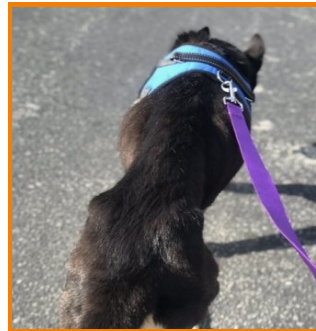

AN AMAZING TRUE STORY ABOUT ONE OF OUR DOGS, COMET, WHO ESCAPED FROM ONE OF OUR VET's OFFICES AFTER SURGERY - FOUND AFTER THREE YEARS because his MICROCHIP was registered to us. Read his story below and remember to get all your pets microchipped and registered.

One of our fosterers drove Comet aka Ghost, a rescued but skitish white shepherd to our vet, because he was limping. We found out that he had been shot and needed surgery. During the night he somehow escaped from the vet's office and jumped two six foot fences. A couple who has a horse and dogs was trying to help and catch him for about a year and a half or more. He was hanging around by them. He had obviously befriended a stray dog when he was lost and took him under his wing, cause that dog was also with him. Finally, the couple was able to catch Comet/Ghost and took in Clyde too. When they took them to their vet, the staff scanned for a chip. Low and behold Comet/Ghost had a microchip registered to us. This is Clyde the dog that Comet/Ghost took under his wing in his survival paths. Ghost was always stronghearted and would look high and low for the ones he loves. The original dog he looked for after his surgery that got lost was the same color as Clyde.

Comet aka Ghost takes time to trust (can't blame him, remember he was shot), but once he does, he loves both two- legged and four deeply.

Betty is an Angel!

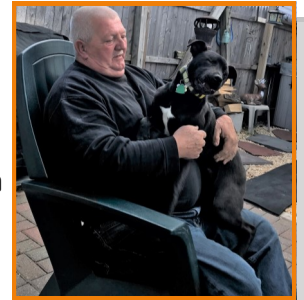
We would dress pup Betty, with one Eye, up so pretty to help find her the most loving home! Yet for a while she had nowhere to go.

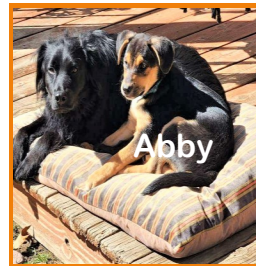

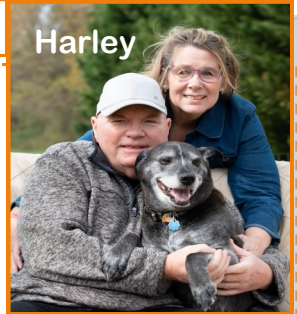

Callie, with her upbeat personality, will help heal Petmom's and her family's hearts.

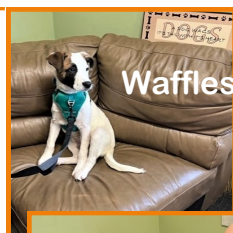

Clara now Coco has a great new sister!

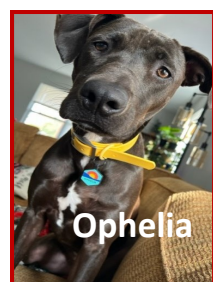
