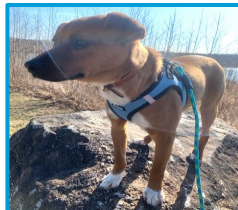

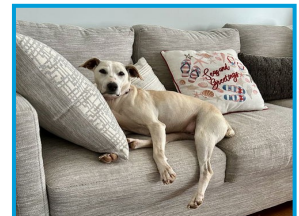

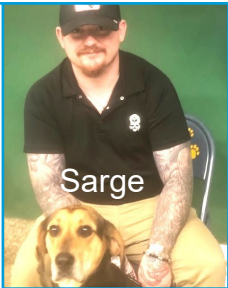
Ready for Training

Sarge's Service Dog Graduation and Celebration

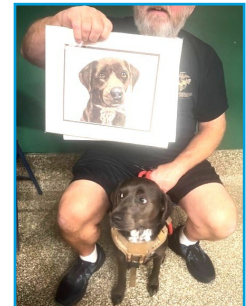
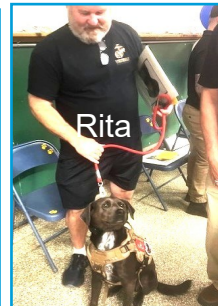

Patrick aka Riggy has an important job ahead of him besides being a loving pet

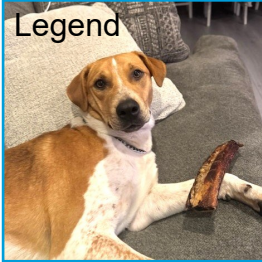

Penny (the little pup held by Her Petmom) is a long way from the terrible life she had. She was very malnourished to the point that our veterinarian diagnosed her with Rickets from not enough nourishment including not enough calcium.

Penny now is very well cared for along with her two small dog siblings - 7 & 11 years old. The young boy in the family knows to be gentle with his pets. One of the dogs could not come in the car to pick up Nixie because she suffers from seizures if stressed out in a long car ride. Petparents take excellent vet care of their animals making sure their dog with seizures gets thorough veterinarian care.

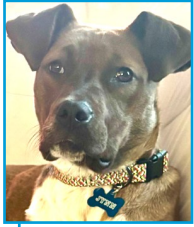

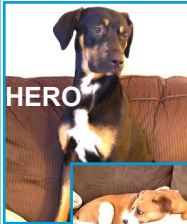

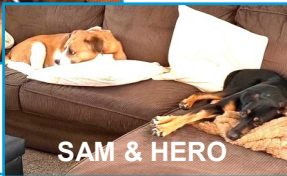
Jasmine aka Jynn is a big comfort To her new family as Eve was!
