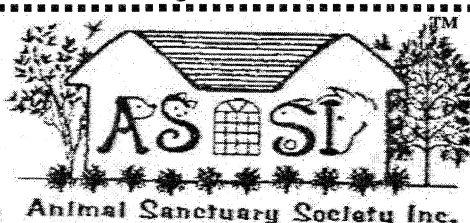

Feline AIDS

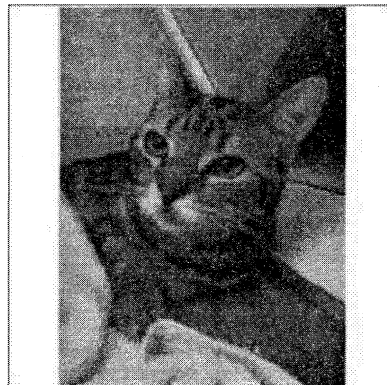
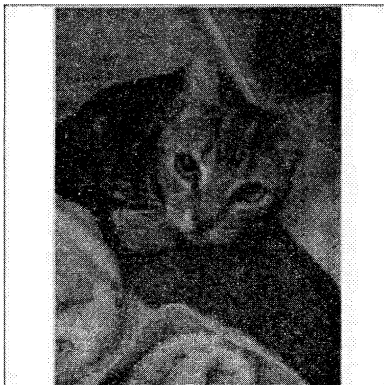

These cats that we have besides testing positive are doing very well otherwise. We do not believe in euthanizing them if their health is doing well. It's not their fault that they tested positive for either aids or leukemia. If you can't adopt now, please send a donation to help with the care of one we presently have & for future ones needing to come to safety.. We have many more aids and leukemia positive cats than we can publish, so please come & visit them.

What you should know about feline AIDS....

Feline immunodeficiency virus, or FIV is a widespread viral infection. The virus devastates a cat's immune system, stopping it from effectively combating other diseases and infections. Infected cats eventually fall prey to a wide variety of secondary illnesses that overwhelmingly prove fatal. It cannot be spread to humans. There is no cure, but cats can live for up to 10 years – much of it in seeming good health. Check the internet for more information.

Vanga is a leukemia positive cat who needs a home along with our many others.

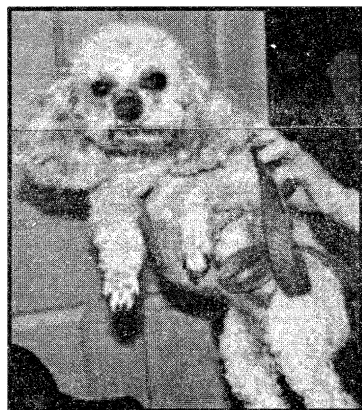
Congo

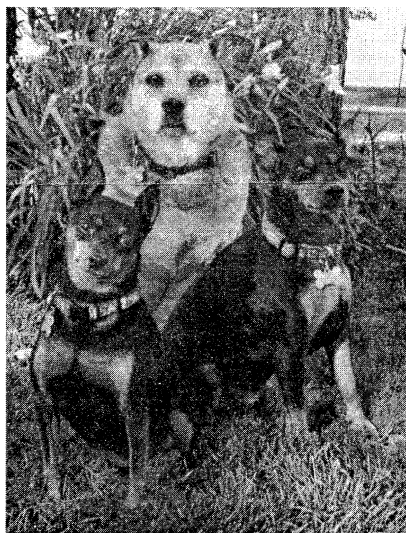
Scout

Scout is a male, miniature poodle. Scouts owners were moving and were unable to keep him.

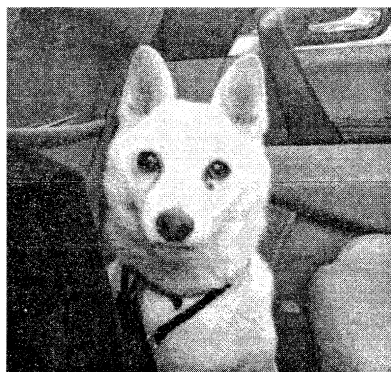


Simon
